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IMPORTANT NOTICE

This tender procedure is governed by the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tender Rules, 2000 as amended from time to time. In case of any conflict between the terms and conditions in the tender document and the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and The Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tender Rules, 2000 the Act and Rules shall prevail.

1.	PREAMBLE
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TamilNadu Magnesite Limited (TANMAG), a Government of TamilNadu Undertaking was established in the year 1979 for mining of Magnesite and Dunite in Kurumbapatti Reserve Forest in Salem District. The Company has three Divisions namely, Mines Division, Shaft Kiln Division (SKD) & Rotary Kiln Division (RKD). The Mines Division undertakes excavation of the mineral resource and the excavated Raw Magnesite (RM) is used for manufacturing of Dead Burnt Magnesite (DBM) at Rotary Kiln Division and Lightly Calcined Magnesite (LCM) at Shaft Kiln Division. DBM, LCM and Dunite, a co-existing mineral obtained during the process of mining Raw Magnesite are all sold by TANMAG to the end customers.

TANMAG now intends to select a Contractor for production and transportation of Raw Magnesite and Dunite for a period of two years. In this context, TANMAG invites e-tender from reputed contractors in "Two Cover System" through transparent bidding process. The Tender notification has been published fixing the date of opening of tender as 28.07.2025 at 14.00 hrs.

2.	SCOPE OF WORK
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The scope of work would inter-alia include the following:

a. The successful bidder shall undertake the following works by semi mechanized methodology engaging required manpower and advanced / modernized machinery for a period of two years.

(A) Mine pits.

- i) Drilling,
- ii) Excavation,
- iii) Grade wise Segregation of Raw Magnesite & Dunite,
- iv) Transportation of Raw Magnesite to RKD & SKD factories after at analysis at TANMAG's laboratory and transportation of Dunite to stock yard near RKD.
- v) Removal of spoil/ rejects and transportation to dumping sites within the mines lease area.

(B) Spoil dumps

- i) Collection of Raw Magnesite and Dunite from spoil dumps.
 - ii) Stacking of Raw Magnesite by grade wise and Dunite by size and variety wise.
 - iii) Transportation of Raw Magnesite after analysis to RKD & SKD factories and Dunite to stock yard near RKD.
- b. All machineries, equipments, tools and implements along with manpower required for undertaking the works stipulated in clause 2(a) shall be arranged by the bidder.
- c. Quantity of Raw Magnesite and Dunite to be produced by the bidder as detailed below:

The number of working days in a month shall be 25 (approx).

- d. The physical properties of Raw Magnesite shall be as below:

- e. The Approximate Lumps and Smalls recovery per day shall be in the following proposition:

- g. The bidder shall not stop/reduce the machineries/workers for any kind of work on his/her/their own and should abide by the instructions of TANMAG officials, failing which action will be taken against the bidder and recovery will be imposed on the bidder accordingly.
- h. The bidder should engage workers/sufficient manpower to achieve the minimum targeted production per day as prescribed in clause 2(c).
- i. All the transport vehicles shall be fitted with GPS tracking system.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BIDDER

a. Drilling (3 sets & above)

- i. Primary drilling - Deep hole drilling with diameter of 110 mm by using Wagon drill machine or equivalent with supporting compressors and towing tippers up to 25 feet depth.
- ii. Secondary drilling (1 & above) - Small hole drilling with diameter of 25 mm by using tractor mounted compressors with required jack hammers up to 5 feet depth.
- iii. Drilling of 2 to 5 feet 25 mm - 40mm \varnothing holes with Jack Hammer for Dunite breaking
- Required 110 mm dia holes/day: 1200 feet/day.
 - Required 25 mm dia holes/day : 200 No's or 400 feet/day.

iv. Working Conditions for Deep hole Drilling

1. All the deep hole drilling shall be done only as wet drilling. No dry drilling is permitted in Mines. If dry drilling is noticed, the deep hole drilling will be stopped immediately & appropriate penalty will be imposed on the bidder. If the condition persists, TANMAG reserves the right to terminate the contract and proceed with suitable alternate arrangements.
2. Deep hole drilling requirements: Drilling of large diameter holes of (4 1/2"ø/110 mm ø) using mobile high pressure portable screw compressor of 450 cfm capacity @ 150 PSI or equivalent with Atlas Copco (BVB-25-10) or equivalent boom height, Wagon drill 110 mm dia drill including DTH hammer, drill rods, hose fitting and operating personnel along with Towing Tipper (Model 2018 or later).
3. Log book has to be maintained for the working of the machines for deep hole drilling & Jack Hammer 2' drilling by the successful bidder.
4. No local/ fabricated wagon drills are acceptable for the above work. Only wagon drills of branded make will be acceptable.
5. Holes shall only be drilled in the place / locations as directed by the mining officials of TANMAG.

b. Digging

- i. The blasted material has to be side casted using excavators.
- ii. Excavation shall be carried out strictly in line with the norms stipulated by Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS).
- iii. Digging excavator required for digging of ore after blasting shall be arranged by the bidder. The excavator shall be L&T Komatsu Hydraulic Excavator/TATA Hitachi Ex200LC or equivalent or higher rated capacity with front end bucket or back hoe type minimum of 0.9 cubic meter bucket capacity - 4 No's, Model - 2018 or later.
- iv. The bidder should make his own arrangements for required tools such as sledge hammers, chipping hammers, iron pan, crow bars, pick axe, spade etc.

c. Segregation

- i. Segregation of Raw Magnesite grade wise & Dunite category wise (Hard grey/ Soft Green) from the blasted materials.
- ii. Magnesite ore has to be well cleaned, dressed and segregated free from Dunite, slaty and other foreign materials and to be stacked as per size and silica percentage to a quantity of 20 MT (approx.). The offered stock should not be more than 2 feet height.
- iii. The Minerals has to be stacked by physical properties and size wise strictly to the requirement of TANMAG before offering the same for sampling. Individual stocks shall be made by each worker with not more than one foot height every day.
- iv. Collection of sample for lab analysis under the supervision of TANMAG representatives. TANMAG shall perform the lab analysis.
- v. The lumps & smalls shall be segregated the next day after washing and separate lumps & smalls stocks shall be made on quality basis.

d. Dunite collection

- i. Collection of Dunite without iron and serpentine coating.
- ii. The size of Dunite lumps has to be maintained between 40 mm and 150mm and should be stacked as Hard Grey and Soft Green separately.
- iii. The production ratio of 60:40 has to be maintained in the category of Hard Grey and Soft Green respectively. However the ratio of production is subject to modification by TANMAG as per the Market demand.
- iv. The machinery used for Spoil and Segregation shall be utilized for removal of residue.
- v. The bidder has to engage required digging machinery (excavator) and jackhammer on his own for drilling, for handling of boulders, etc., the depth of the jackhammer holes shall be minimum 2 feet each. Less than 2 feet holes will not be blasted due to safety reasons.

- vi. Reasonably smaller size boulders shall be broken manually and bigger boulders which could not be broken manually shall be drilled for blasting.
- vii. Less than 40 mm size of Dunite should be collected and stacked separately. Once sufficient quantity is stacked it will be transported to RKD.
- viii. Dunite lumps in size more than 150 mm and without uniform quality will be rejected categorically at the site and will not be permitted for despatch.
- ix. Sizing of Dunite shall be done using both Rock breaker (TATA HITACHI 140 Hydraulic Rock breaker or equivalent, Model 2018 (or) later & Manpower.

e. Spoil Removal

- i. By using excavators and dumpers, the spoil shall be removed and dumped in dump yard located at Mine lease area after Weighment. The maximum radial distance to dump yard shall be 4 KM.

Raw Magnesite: Spoil = 1 MT:20 MT (minimum)

Required units : 4

Required machineries : ➤ Make: L&T KOMATSU / TATA HITACHI / Kobelco, SANY, Hyundai, CLG etc. or equivalent / higher rated capacity.

➤ Hydraulic Excavator EX200 LC, 2018 (or) later - 4No's.

➤ Tippers 25 MT capacity/ higher capacity, Model 2018 (or) later -20 No's.

Required spare tippers : 2No's for replacement for continuation of work.

- i. Weighment shall be done at TANMAG weighbridge before dumping the spoil in dump yard.
- ii. Collection and recovery of Raw Magnesite completely from spoil dump yard has to be undertaken by deploying adequate manpower.
- iii. All the boulders shall be cleared off from the loading site. No boulders shall be left as residue at the loading site.

- iv. The number of tippers may be increased / decreased as per the requirements, without affecting the tonnage to be handled per day.
- v. TANMAG has the right to change/reallocate the loading/ unloading places as per the requirement and will be deployed anywhere at mines. The actual number of tippers deployed for each excavator may change as per the TANMAG's discretion which will be decided based on the ground conditions and requirement.
- vi. The materials shall be allowed to load only within the rated capacity of the tipper.
- vii. The ratio of RM to spoil has to be maintained as mentioned above (Minimum 1:20)

f. Transportation

- i. After lab analysis, grade wise Raw Magnesite to be transported to RKD & SKD factories and Dunite to be transported to stock yard near RKD. The maximum distance from Mines to RKD shall be 5 kms and from Mines to SKD shall be 1.5 kms.
- ii. Raw Magnesite transportation from Mines to RKD & SKD Factories has to be undertaken as per requirement (RKD approx 150 MT/day, SKD approx 70 MT/day) and loading of Raw Magnesite should be done manually. JCB can be used for loading of RM & Dunite subject to the condition that RM & Dunite shall be manually loaded in the JCB bucket. Then the minerals shall be loaded in to the tippers. JCB shall be fitted with camera for monitoring the same.

Transportation of Raw Magnesite

Machinery requirement : 10 MT Tipper 6 No's (or) 20 MT Tipper - 3 Nos'
(Model 2018 (or) later)

Manpower required : 36 Nos.

Transportation of Dunite

Machinery requirement : 10 MT Tipper 8 No's / 20 MT Tipper - 4 No's
(Model 2018 (or) later)

Manpower required : 48 Nos.

- iii. The Weighment of Raw Magnesite/ Dunite weighed at Mines Weigh Bridge should be tallied with the Weighment at RKD / SKD Weigh Bridge. Variation in the Weighment between the weighbridges should be within the tolerance limit of 50-70 Kgs per Tipper.
- iv. If the successful bidder fails to transport the required quantity of Raw Magnesite / Dunite from Mines to RKD / SKD yard and as specified, TANMAG will make alternate arrangements and the cost incurred towards the same will be recovered from the bidder.
- v. The quantity mentioned will have fluctuation based on demand from customer, RKD and SKD factories. TANMAG shall be at liberty to increase / decrease the quantity and to stop the contract at any time without giving prior intimation to the bidder.

g. General

- i. Tools sharpening should be done by the successful bidder on their own.
- ii. Raw Magnesite slaty material is to be stacked separately as and when available.
- iii. The successful bidder shall appoint a supervisor to supervise the works undertaken at mines and the person shall be present throughout the working hours. Necessary records as required for statutory purpose maintained by the successful bidder shall be produced for cross- verification of any data by TANMAG officials.
- iv. All machineries, equipments and manpower provided are only minimum requirements and the successful bidder shall deploy adequate machineries, equipments and manpower required to achieve the production per day as specified in clause 2(c).

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF TANMAG

- 1. Blasting will be the responsibility of TANMAG's.
- 2. Conducting of lab test for estimating the silica percentage availability in Raw Magnesite at TANMAG Lab and the results shall be final and binding on the bidder.

3. Marking of mines boundary area.
4. Providing drinking water upto the storage facility tank of the bidder.
5. TANMAG would provide electricity at single point and medical facility for which the charges should be borne by the bidder.
6. Providing required dewatering arrangements in bottom benches, if required.

6. LANGUAGE OF THE TENDER

If the supporting documents are in a language other than English/Tamil, the notarized translated English version of the documents should also be enclosed. Tender received without such translation copy will be rejected.

- a. EMD for the tender is fixed as Rs.35,80,200.00 (Rupees Thirty five lakhs and eighty thousand and two hundred Only)
- b. Bidder has to select the payment option as “pay online” to pay the EMD amount. Only after payment of EMD, bidder will be able to encrypt / upload their bids. In order to avoid last minute lapses, it is recommended to make payment and submit the bid as early as possible. TANMAG is not responsible for any sort of difficulty faced / failure in submission of bids online by the bidder.
- c. Tenders should be submitted through online e-portal URL, address <https://tntenders.gov.in/nicgep/app>
- d. Bid submission through online ends on 28.08.2025 at 14.00 hrs.
- e. Uploading of tender documents only in the portal mentioned above will be considered. Other than this specified portal, tender shall not be considered. Hard copy of tender shall not be entertained.
- f. Non-submission/Non-remittance of EMD within the stipulated date and time will entail outright rejection of bids.
- g. EMD Exemption can be availed by enclosing a certificate issued by the competent authority (viz MSME/NSIC, banker’s cheque, specified small saving instrument..) along with Technical offer.
- h. In case of Joint Venture, the EMD may be provided by either of the members.
